MW/DW explained changes going forwards in the way the medical centre will operate, this is on the back of the guidance issued by NHS Lothian:-

When asked to attend the surgery, all patients will be asked to wear a face covering going forwards.

There will be no covid helpline available – concerns will be raised via GP's.

Vaccinations will no longer take place within the medical centre; these will be carried out by the Community Team.

Changes taking place will be publicized but as yet no timeframe is available.

Once full information is available, the PPG will meet to see how best they can support the Medical Centre by relaying information to patients and to support the Medical Centre going forwards.

The Medical centre will be closed on Good Friday 15 April, and Easter Monday 18 April. An additional holiday on 3 June for the Queen's jubilee where the medical Centre will be closed.
