



Provision of External Rails

External Rails

An external metal rail is used to assist a person to mobilise over a step or if additional support is needed when opening or locking a door. A grab rail can be fitted beside an external step or at an external doorway to provide support. When considering rails at your front door, if it is possible, its best to fit them at the same side as the door handle.

As standard, East Lothian Health and Social Care Partnership no longer provide external rails.

Purchase:

You can purchase external grab rails in many local hardware stores or can purchase online. The suppliers below are only a few of some recognised retailers that provide these to purchase, there are many more online options available at a range of costs.

Installation:

External handrails over several steps can also be fabricated by a blacksmith. If you require someone to install this for you, East Lothian Council has a trusted trader list on their website.
